ESU has released several new sound files for the Select decoder line including the MP40PH-3C and a full set of Alco's including the 244 and 251. They are working on full lineup of additional sounds to be available in 2012. Lots of good stuff here.

TCS has added several new features to their decoder line including phased dual strobes, dual flicker, adjustable headlight brightness, and adjustable function dimming that is mappable. All TCS decoders are now RailCom compatible to allow bi-directional communications for advanced control of your trains and layout. All TCS decoders now support CV66 and CV95, Forward and Reverse Motor Trim, which now allows them to be easily matched to most major decoders on the market. All of the new features are available on TCS decoder having firmware version 86 or higher (Ref CV8).
